## **Order Picker Attachment**

Order Picker Attachments - Order picking is likewise called order preparation operation. This is one of the key processes within a warehouse and consists of people called order pickers, collecting and taking articles in a specific quantity before shipment in order to fulfill client orders. Order picking is a simple warehousing process. The effectiveness in which this particular job is completed can be directly connected to the productivity of a supply chain. Thus, order picking is amongst the most controlled logistic methods. Order picking falls within the category of the warehouse management system.

There are some specific kinds of order picking. The main kinds comprise: pick to box method, wave picking method, piece picking or picker to part method, sorting systems method and zone picking method.

The pick to box method involves the order picker just filling the boxes with things that are from their particular station. The box then moves on to other locations to until the order is complete. In this particular method, there is no movement of the order picker staff. In the wave picking method, the order pickers move around to collect the needed items for numerous orders. The picker to part method or piece picking is similar where the order pickers or picker move to gather the items needed but for one order only.

In the sorting systems method, there is no movement of the order picking staff. Instead, the things are delivered to him or her through an automated system like for instance a conveyor system or an automatic storage. In the zone picking method, each order picker is assigned to one particular area. They are responsible for just realizing order picking in this particular area.
